West Virginia v. B.P.J.

Timeline

March-April 2021 West Virginia passed HB 3293, the "Save Women's Sports Act." May 2021 Student B.P.J. sued in the Southern District of West Virginia, Charleston Division. July 2021 The district court temporarily blocked West Virginia from enforcing the law against B.P.J., which allowed B.P.J. to play on the girls' teams while the case is pending. January 2023 The district court dissolved the preliminary injunction that it initially put in place and ruled that the "Save Women's Sports Act" is constitutional. February 2023 The district court denied B.P.J.'s Motion for Stay Pending Appeal. B.P.J. filed a Motion for Stay Pending Appeal with the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. The United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit grants B.P.J.'s request to keep playing on the girls' teams while the appeal was being decided. March 2023 B.P.J. filed appeal in the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. West Virginia filed a motion asking the Supreme Court to remove the Fourth Circuit's injunction. The Supreme Court declined to vacate the Fourth Circuit's April 2023 injunction. The Court did not rule on the merits of the case. August 2023 The United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit denied West Virginia's motion to suspend the injunction

pending appeal based on B.P.J.'s improvement in sports.

November 2025 <u>Brief of respondent B.P.J.</u>, by her next friend and mother,

Heather Jackson filed.

December 2025 Reply of West Virginia, et al. submitted.

January 13, 2026 Oral arguments before the United States Supreme Court.
